

2018 Farms For City Kids Application/City Kids Adventure Learning Program Application

The 2018 Farms For City Kids program will begin February 19, 2018 and conclude the week of November 9, 2018. As a reminder, our program runs through the summer months. We are accepting applications for children in grades 4-7, accompanied by two to three teachers and/or chaperones. Parent chaperones are discouraged. The maximum number of students is 25 children and the minimum is 15.

Teachers who are new to our program must attend an orientation. New Teacher Orientation will be held the weekend of October 7 and 8, 2017, April 7 and 8, 2018, and July 7 and 8, 2018. Returning teachers are always welcome. The orientation is a required step in securing your week on the Farm. Please contact the Education Director for more details.

Farms For City Kids Foundation offers the program at no charge to schools. Transportation to and from Spring Brook Farm, as well as teacher compensation, is the responsibility of participating schools.

The deadline for submitting this application is December 31, 2017. Notification of scheduling begins after January 15, 2018. Please submit application to:

Scheduling Policy

Every reasonable effort is made to accommodate the desired dates for attendance listed on the application. However, the number of annual applicants makes it nearly impossible to schedule every school or group that applies. If we are unable to schedule your group for the weeks submitted on the application, then you will be notified of any open slots. If we are still unable to schedule your school for the current year, then you have a preferred slot for scheduling in the next year's application process. Schools that applied last year but were left unscheduled will be scheduled first, after their application has been received. When listing dates of choice, please be sure to give weeks in three different months that you would be willing to attend. You will receive notification of acceptance by email and/or standard mail. Please be sure to provide accurate email and physical addresses in order to receive notification.

The Adventure Learning Program is a new program intended for FARM alumni. Students should be between the ages of 12-18. The lessons will focus on wilderness skills and forging a stronger bond with nature, yet remain centered on teamwork, critical thinking skills, independence, and self-confidence. The skills learned during this week will remain valuable throughout their lifetime.

Students will learn proper techniques for starting a camp, emergency shelter building, fire building, camp crafts, safe knife use, identification of edibles, 'Leave No Trace' principals, and map and compass skills.

Due to limited space, the maximum number of enrolled students for this program is 15. The Adventure Learning program is 100% staffed by Farms For City Kids education staff, including overnights. It is possible for teachers to be attending the Farms For City Kids Program with a full roster of students AND bring an additional 15 Farm Alumni to be enrolled in the Adventure Program WITHOUT providing supervision. However, teachers are more than welcome to attend!

Transportation and teacher compensation are the responsibility of the attending school.
